"The Happy Heart Party started in 2003 as an annual party for all patients and their families of The Congenital Heart Institute of Florida (CHIF) [www.chif.us] and All Children's Hospital [http://www.allkids.org]. The Congenital Heart Institute of Florida operates on around 800 patients every year.

Patients come to our party every year. Our first party was in 2003. The parties in 2003 and 2004 were funded in part by a donation of \$1000 per year from my wife Stacy. Since then, the party has been funded by The Krewe of the Conquistadors of Panfilo de Narvaez. The Krewe was founded by Dave Puckett. On August 21, 1998, Dave's daughter Allyson underwent open heart surgery to repair an AV Canal at the age of 2 years. Allyson continues to do very well! I was her surgeon. Her father Dave founded The Krewe and led The Krewe to become sponsors of The Happy Heart Party.

The Happy Heart Party provides young parents with young children with congenital heart disease the opportunity to interact with teenagers and young adults who had surgery 10 or 20 years ago and are now leading meaningful productive and healthy lives!! The Happy Heart Party also provides an opportunity for physicians, nurses, and other health care professionals to interact with their patients young and old in a fun social setting. For me, it is one of the highlights of the year – a truly special day!"
